The amounts specified on your order form will be sent to the organizations you have chosen. When your order and check are received in the office, you will receive an e-mail letting you know that your order is being processed. A member of the Outreach Committee will send a card to your recipient(s) to let him/her know of the donation in their name.

12. Habitat for Humanity – Murray/Calloway \$10



Murray Calloway County Habitat for Humanity is a locally run affiliate of Habitat for Humanity International, a nonprofit, ecumenical Christian housing organization. Habitat for Humanity works in partnership with people in need to build and renovate decent, affordable housing. The houses then are sold to those in need at no profit and with no interest charged. The late Rev. Dr. David Roos was an enthusiastic supporter of the Murray chapter of Habitat for Humanity. “When you give to Habitat you are investing in an unlimited future,” Roos stated at the dedication of one Habitat for Humanity home. He called donations to the program “not so much charity as capital and instead of a handout, a hand up. This is the better way in the long run for us all!”

CONNECTION: Partner with individuals, congregations, and organizations to serve the needs of the world;

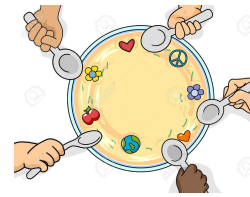
